**Evidence Based Homeopathy: Extensive documentation of
successfully treated cases considered incurable by
conventional medicine**

Abstract:

Clinical verification is the key concern of Evidence-based Homeopathy (EBH). Dr. Cámpora will present two cases of BRECHA, the Argentinian research database of homeopathic cases. Both are vedoerecording cases. The first is a severe psychiatric case: an 11-year old child, diagnosed with a dysthymic disorder (early onset) plus delusional disorder (persecutory type). The second and difficult case is 19-year old girl, with congenital megacolon (Hirschsprung disease) that presents severe incontinence of 19 years of duration. Both cases had been treated previously with conventional medicine and different psychological approaches for many years, and also with homeopathic remedies. Cases will be analyzed in detail with an emphasis placed on: 1. The verbatim expressions of the patient and their precise translation into the exact rubrics of the repertory. 2. Case analysis and methodological approach. 3 Treatment and follow up. Finally, it will be highlighted, that when high-quality cases traditionally considered incurable are cured, these represent undeniable homeopathic evidence.
